Description

The City of Eden hosted two public meetings in support of its Comprehensive Plan project, with the dual objective of informing residents about the project and collecting input from the community to be used in the Plan. The two meetings featured an open house format, which allowed residents to visit at any time during meeting hours to browse the materials and have conversations with project staff. The City advertised the meetings on their website and social media. Town staff and Stewart employees were present at both meetings to answer questions and discuss the project with attendees. Attendees were also encouraged to take the online Community Survey.

Both meetings featured the same mix of informational posters and maps along with materials deisgned to collect community input. The results of the input boards are summarized below.



 - No empty buildings make them available for rent.


Facilities
