

RECYCLING UPDATE CITY OF EDEN

The City of Eden will not be able to offer curbside recycling this year, but our recycling center located on Mebane Bridge Road will continue to accept recyclable materials from city residents. The curbside recycling campaign to reach the 200 residents necessary to implement the program was not successful. Only 139 residents signed up for the program which made the program cost prohibitive.

The Recycling Center is located at 123 Mebane Bridge Road and is open to city residents Tuesday thru Sunday from 9 am to 5 pm.

Residents must see the attendant prior to unloading. An attendant is on site and available to help with your recycle needs.

When residents make their first visit to the facility please be prepared to show your drivers license and registration in order to receive a recycle sticker that will be placed by the attendant on the right bottom corner of the vehicle back glass that will allow you to access the facility in the future. Any vehicle entering the facility without a sticker will have to be verified.

Residents are asked to separate recyclables at the facility. Bins are clearly marked as to where items should be placed.

The following items **ARE ACCEPTED:**

- Metal/White Goods & Appliances
- Plastic Bottles & Containers
- Cardboard that is broken down
- Newspapers, Magazines & Junk Mail
- Recyclable Oil & Filters
- Batteries
- Latex & Oil Based Paints
- Aluminum, Tin and Metal Cans
- Glass Bottles & Jars

The following items **ARE NOT ACCEPTED:**

(These items must be taken to the Rockingham County Landfill located at 281 Shuff Road, Madison, NC)

- Household Hazardous Waste
- Styrofoam or Packing Peanuts of any kind
- TV's or Discarded Computer Equipment
- Household Trash
- Cooking Oil
- Wax Coated Cardboard

- Tires
- Antifreeze
